



Spanish rock star

 With the Rock of Gibraltar providing its backdrop, there are few more spectacular places in Europe to play golf than at La Hacienda Links Golf Resort in southern Spain. The resort's Links course – weighing in at 6,388 yards – made a triumphant return in 2022 following a complete reconfiguration and redesign by American golf architect Kurtis Bowman.

Running along the beachfront and offering majestic views of the Mediterranean, Gibraltar and Africa, the project was one of the most exciting to take place in European golf last year. It is part of a multi-million-Euro investment, making La Hacienda one of the continent's flagship 36-hole golf venues.

In addition to the new-look Links layout, the resort has also opened a

contemporary clubhouse, a driving range, an upgraded practice area and a new beach bar and restaurant, named 'Sal Verde', in the last 12 months.

Further investment in 2023 will include La Hacienda's other 18-hole championship layout – the Heathland – undergoing a series of upgrades, the launch of a new state-of-the-art website and a new halfway house opening on the Links course. In another exciting development, next year will see the luxury golf experience bar raised even higher with the opening of a new 323-room Fairmont hotel.

La Hacienda Links Golf Resort is also easy to reach from the United Kingdom, with direct flights available to both Gibraltar and Malaga airports.
